This year, we greatly increased our reach within the Chapel Hill community with both the Bowden Road farm stand and the Cedar Falls Park farmer's market over the summer. With the completion of the greenhouse this past February, we were also able to expand our plant sales in the spring. Out at the farm, we built soil, grew our microbe community, fed worms, encouraged the

growth of beneficial insect populations, put lots of roots in the ground, sequestered carbon, and as a side effect of this, we harvested some food!
